「New Hokkaido Style」 Declaration

7 Points for Peace of Mind

We ask for businesses to cooperate and implement the following upon reopening.

1. Ensure that all staff wear masks and frequently wash their hands.
 2. Thoroughly monitor the health condition of the staff.
 3. Regularly ventilate and air out your facility.
 4. Regularly sanitize and wash facility equipment, etc.

5. Limit the chances for person-to-person contact.

- Ensure safe distance (2 meters)
- Use barriers, capacity limits, etc. to ensure open seats

6. Call upon customers to wash their hands and follow proper cough etiquette.

7. Proactively inform your customers about your efforts.

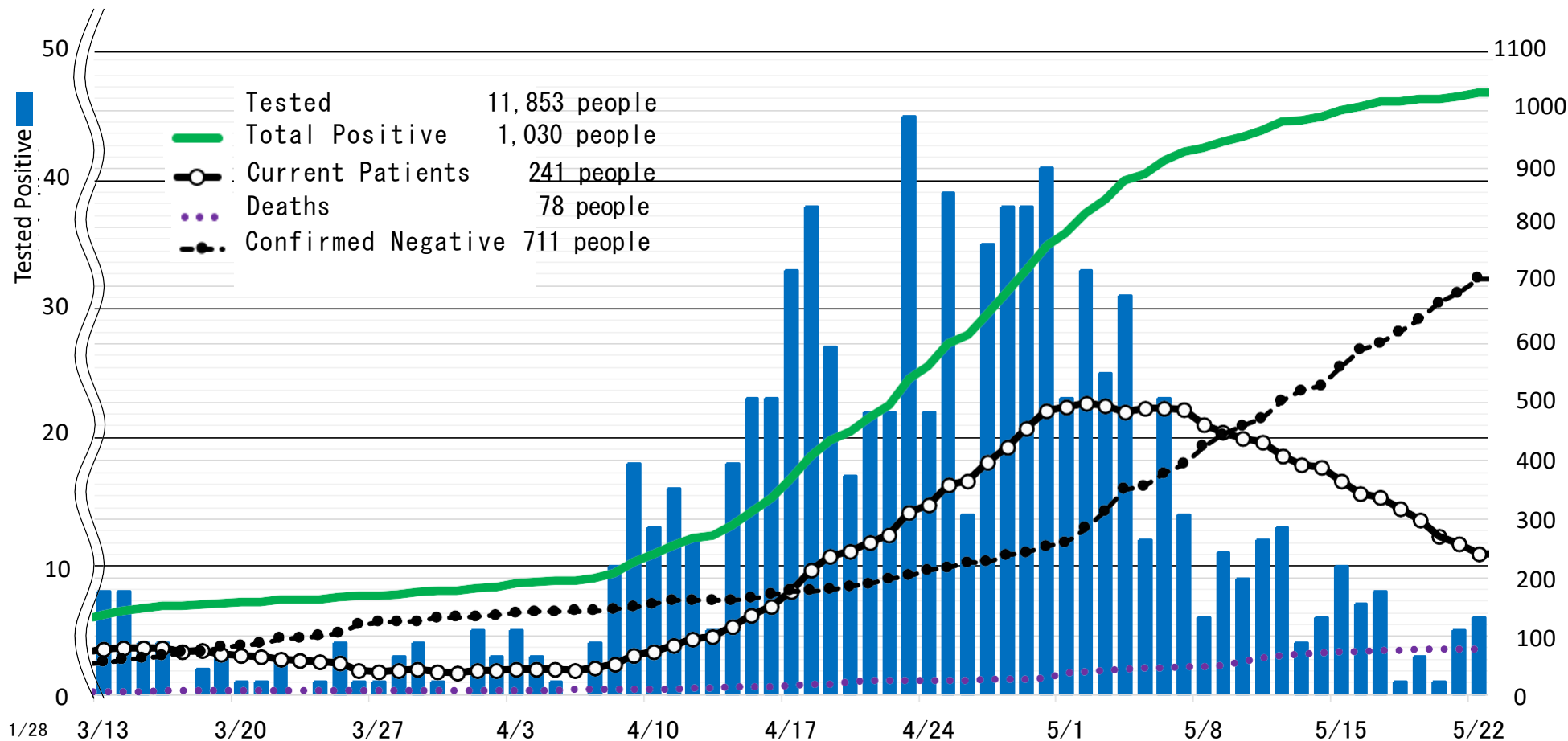

COVID-19 RELATED PATIENTS IN HOKKAIDO

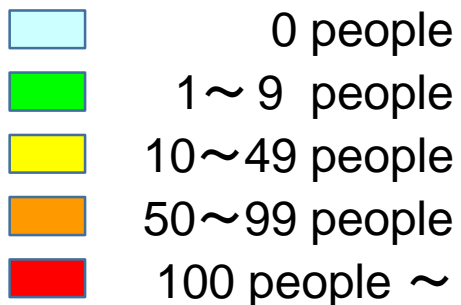
The spread of infection has slowed drastically.



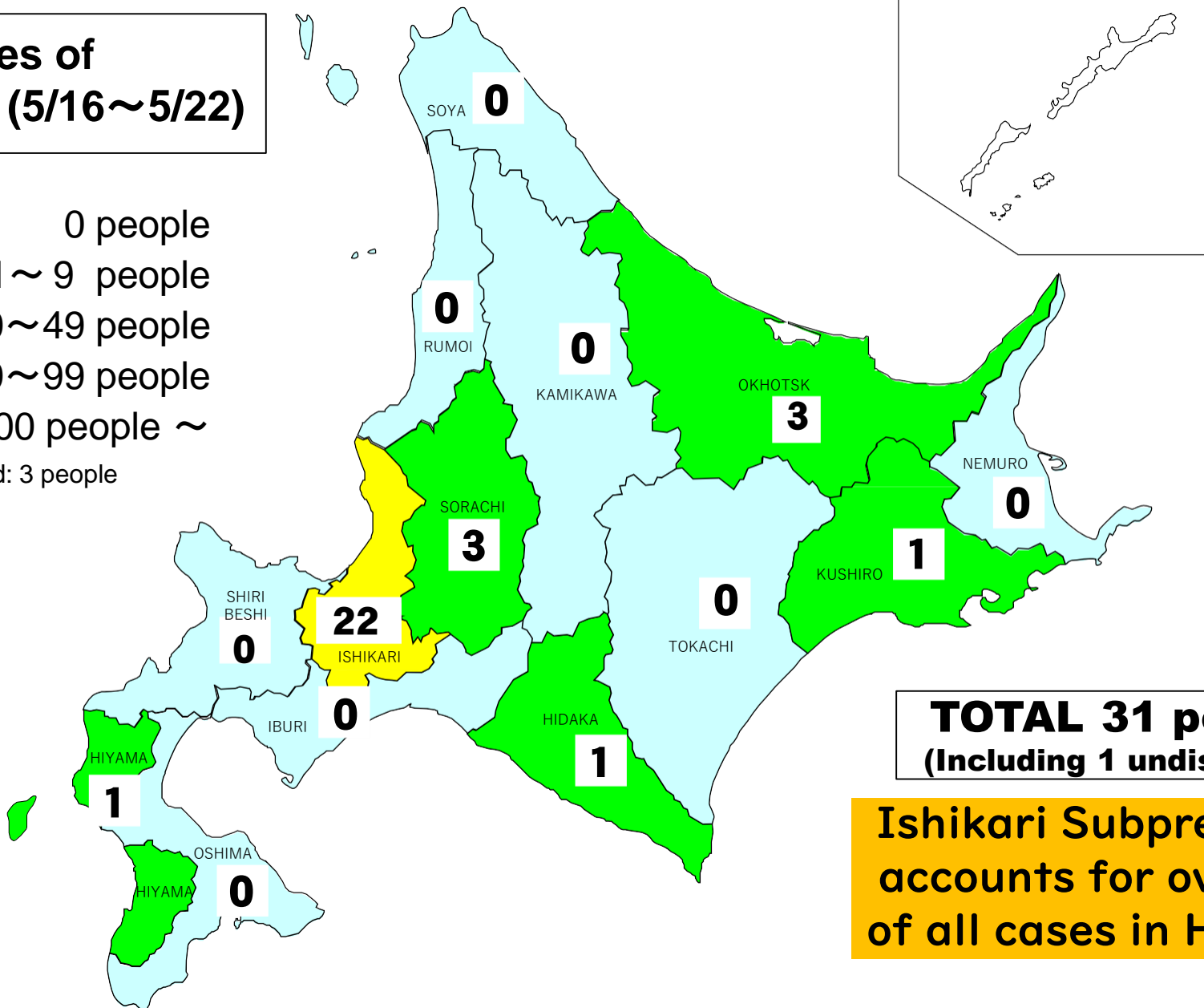
Current Information on COVID-19 Related Patients in Hokkaido (As of May 22, 2020)

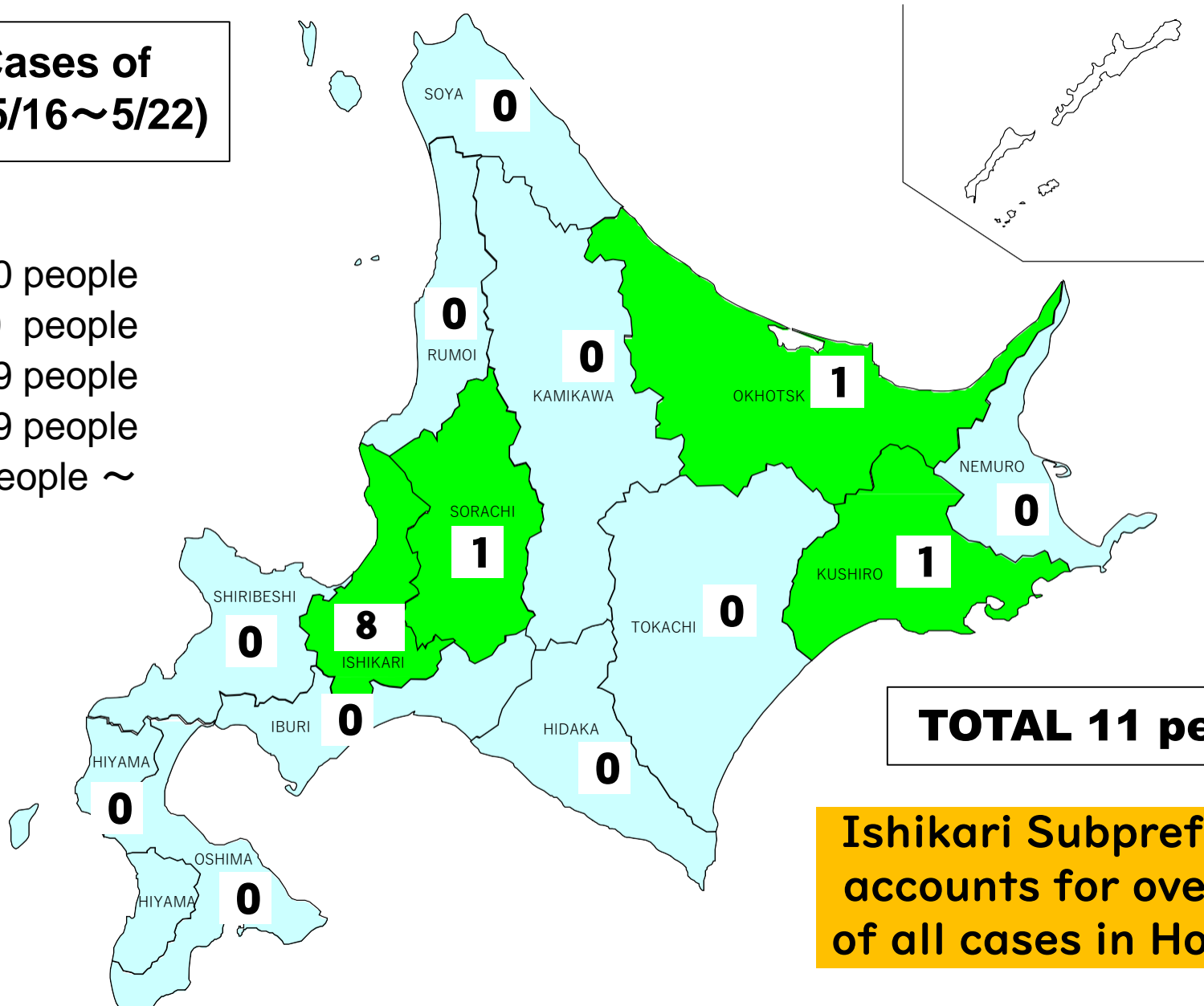
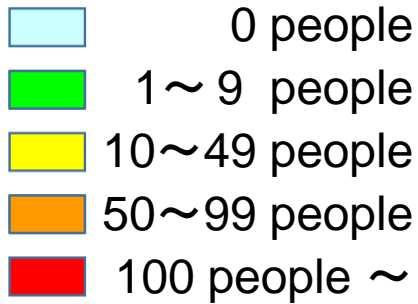

STRENGTHENING MEDICAL CARE AT ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

- **Strengthen the medical care at some of the current accommodation medical facilities by positioning them as **Temporary Medical Facilities:****
- ✓ **Placement of resident doctors (from Sapporo Medical University)**
- ✓ **Cooperation with pharmacies operated by the Hokkaido Pharmaceutical Association**
- ✓ **Acceptance of elderly patients or patients with preexisting conditions that present mild symptoms.**
