

I have a license issued from another country. Will I be able to convert it to a Japanese license while I am in Hokkaido?

## Yes, if you meet the following conditions, you can convert your foreign license to a Japanese license in Hokkaido.



- 1. You have an address within Hokkaido.
- 2. You continuously resided in the country that issued the license for 3 or more months after receiving the license, and can show proof of this.
- 3. The foreign license is still valid.









• It is often difficult for people to gather proof that they remained in their country for 3 months after receiving their license. Please try and gather as many forms of proof as possible.

(Ex: Immigration Record, Driving Record, Rental Contract, Academic Enrollment Record, Employment Record, etc)

- The application process depends on location, so be sure to confirm at the Driver's License Test Center which has jurisdiction over your address for more information.

  (Driver's License Test Centers are located in: Sapporo, Hakodate, Asahikawa, Obihiro, Kushiro, and Kitami.)
- Depending on the country the license was issued in, the mandatory documents and procedures may vary, so make sure to double check the requirements.
- The Driver's License Test Centers are very busy, so the wait for an appointment can sometimes exceed 6 months. Once you have gathered the required documents, try and make your appointment as promptly as possible.
- Appointments must be made over the phone. The staff only speak Japanese, so if you
  have trouble making the call in Japanese, please contact the Hokkaido Foreign Resident
  Support Center for help.
