



DON'T FORGET TO PAY VEHICLE TAX!

This leaflet is based on information from the websites of Hokkaido Prefecture and Sapporo City.

REGULAR VEHICLES

Individuals in possession of a vehicle (660cc or more) as of April 1st are required to pay the vehicle tax under the classification of Regular Vehicles. The amount is dependent on engine displacement.

Payment Deadline: June 2nd, 2025 (Monday) *Payment slips are mailed out in early May.

How to pay: the following 4 payment methods are available.

① Cashless Payment

You can complete the payment procedure by accessing either 1 [Regional Tax Payment Site](#) or 2 [Hokkaido Vehicle Tax Payment Site](#) from your computer, smartphone, or tablet.

② Smartphone Apps

You can complete the payment procedure by scanning the barcode or 2D code printed on the payment slip through your preferred payment app on your smartphone or tablet.

③ Cash Payment

You can pay the Regular Vehicle Tax using cash at the following locations.

◆ Financial Institutions, Japan Post Bank, Hokkaido Tax Office Counters ◆ Convenience Stores

④ Automatic Bank Withdrawal*

*If it is your first time registering, automatic withdrawals will start from the **next tax year**.

LIGHT VEHICLES

Individuals in possession of a light vehicle etc. ★ as of April 1st are required to pay the Light Vehicle Tax. The amount is dependent on engine displacement.



The **payment deadline, payment method, and help desk** for Light Vehicle Tax **vary by municipality**. Please inquire at your local government office for details.

★ Light vehicle, etc.: motorcycle, light vehicle, special small motor vehicle, two-wheeled small vehicle

If you **need an interpreter** when making inquiries, please contact the **Hokkaido Foreign Resident Support Center**.

The tax payment slip is mailed to the address as of April 1st on your vehicle inspection certificate (shaken-sho)

If you change your address or name, **you need to update the information on your vehicle inspection certificate** at the local District Transport Bureau.
